## **Site Supervisor(s)**

This position requires on site safety management and supervision of technical staff and volunteers. The OTE season traditionally runs from mid-April to late November. In 2010, this position requires both as a casual, contract event-based person(s), as well as a full time, annual salaried individual . Hourly rates are based on \$35.00 to \$45.00 per hr built into a flat rate per event compensation package with additional financial benefits to be negotiated. Full time annual salary-based position is available ranging from \$42,000.00 to \$62,500.00 with additional financial benefits to be negotiated.
